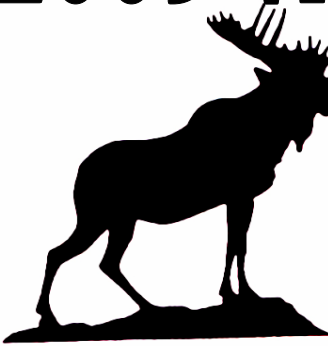

Rules

1. All men bowlers must be Loyal Order of the Moose members in good standing and USBC Certified. All women bowlers must be Women of the Moose members in good standing and USBC Certified. All bowlers will be required to show a valid Moose or WOTM card and a valid USBC Certification card at check-in time, which is 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time. Also, your lodge or chapter must be in good standing with VMA at the time of bowling. Bowlers with no valid USBC card may pay unattached fees at the time of bowling.
2. If there are more than one squad in an event, a bowler may only participate once, unless an emergency occurs for which the House Chairman may authorize a member of the Host Lodge that has already bowled to replace a bowler. If this occurs, then the bowler will only be allowed to use his first entry for All Events. To qualify for Senior Award bowler must be 55 at time of bowling
3. Team Event: 2 Men—2 Women 3 Games
Doubles Event: 1 Man-1 Women 5 Games
All events: 2 Divisions— Men's & Women's 8 Games Total
4. Tournament Averages: All bowlers will use their highest USBC averages for 2008-2009 (21 game minimum). Summer league averages will not count. Bowlers with no average for 2008-2009 will use their highest current average (21 game minimum) as of Oct. 31, 2009. All others will bowl scratch. If a submitted average is different than the actual average, the handicap will be adjusted for the correct average. Bowlers using an Oct. 31, 2009 average must submit written verification at the time of entry. Last minute substitutions using an October 31, average will have 5 days to submit written verification of average.
5. Handicap: Will be 80% of 220 for all bowlers, using a single game chart and added to a bowler's actual score.
6. There is no 10-pin rule for this tournament. Report of previous prize winnings will not apply, USBC Rule #319-D and #319-E will not apply.
7. All prize money will be returned 100%. The tournament will pay at least one place for every 10 entries in each event, except All Events, which will pay 1 place for every 20 entries and split in 2 divisions—Men and Women.

9. If more than 1 squad, bowlers will be notified of squad times only if these times are different from the times they requested, additional shifts may be added prior to the start of the tournament, November 1, 2009.
10. The House Chairman is Garland Branch and the Tournament Director is Bud Stump. Any questions not covered by USBC tournament playing rules will be the decision of the Tournament Director and House Chairman. Their decision will be final, unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule #320.

12. In the event of a lane breakdown and bowlers have to move to a different pair, there will be no additional practice.
