

Dear Collegians and Star Recorders:

We wanted to give everyone a heads up on next years College and Star Retreat Weekend! It was proposed and accepted that we would hold our weekend at Mountain Lake in Pembroke, VA. This is where Dirty Dancing was filmed. We have lodging blocked in the Richmond/Thompson Cabins, Chestnut Lodge and the Main Hotel. You can call during the winter season 9-5 Monday through Friday. After May 4th you may phone between 6:00 am and 11:00 pm daily. The prices will be in the system after January 2012 and will drop July 9th, 2012 so make your reservations early. These rooms are being held in the name of the Women of the Moose.

Our rate is \$200.00 a night single occupancy a night for a two night stay. Each additional person in the room is \$50.00 per night. (Ex 2 people per room is \$250.00 per night). This rate includes Friday dinner, Saturday breakfast/lunch/dinner and Sunday Breakfast. There are two beds in all rooms with different bed configurations. If you have a group coming and would like to stay in one of their larger cabins you can talk to Anita Hines and she can work something out for you. We have the meeting hall on Saturday for our meeting and they will furnish us with coffee, tea, water for the day and either a morning or afternoon snack, but we will work that out as it gets closer. We will need a count July 1st of the amount of co-workers attending each of the meals so that they can reserve our places. On Friday and Saturday it is their October Fest with an Oompa Band; beer tasting and German Buffet our tickets to this event are included in the cost of our package, but we will need to know how many will be attending and which night or both nights as reservations are required early.
