Accolades

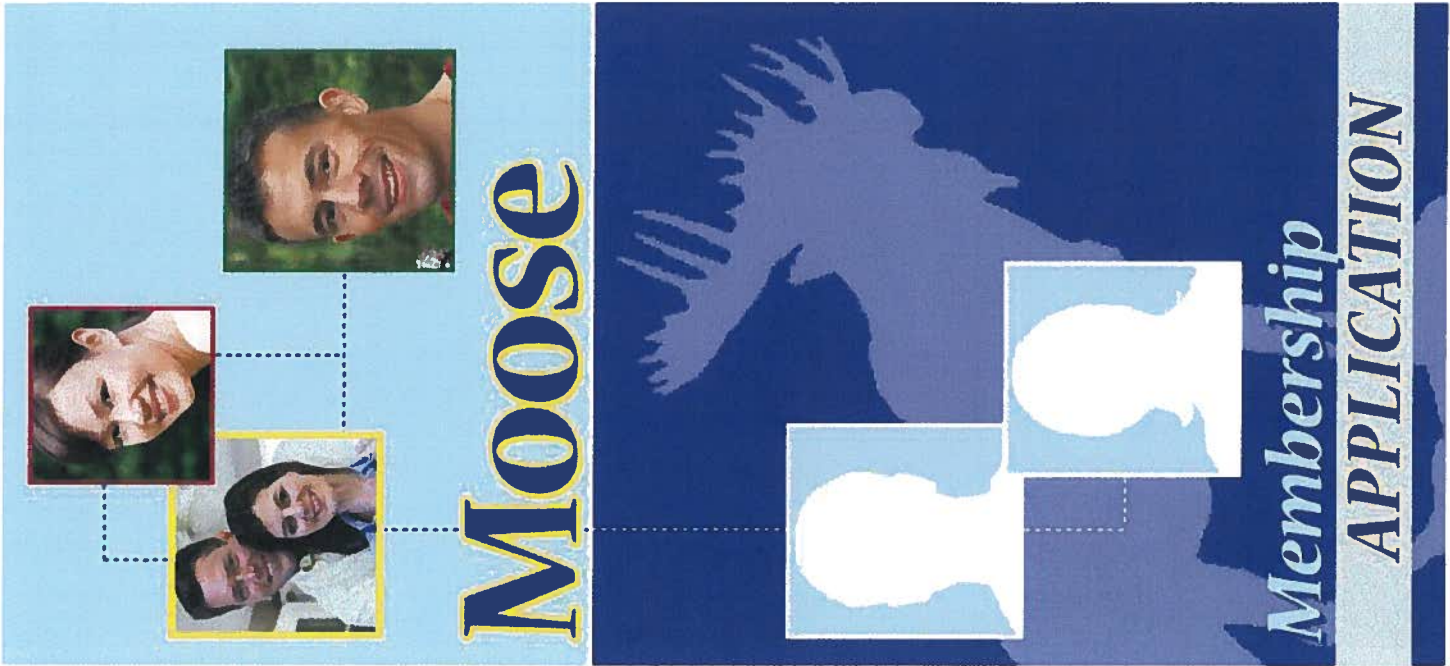
