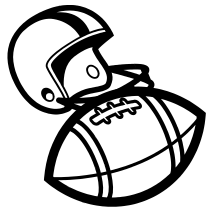
Governor's Corner

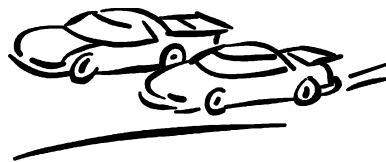







You showed the heart of a Moose member in many ways this holiday season and your lodge is grateful and thankful for your membership and spirit.

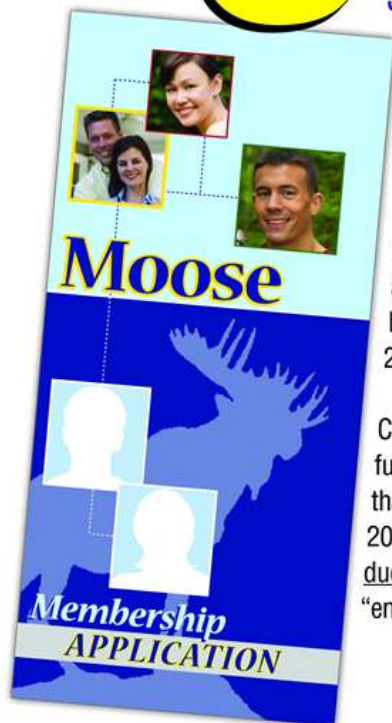
