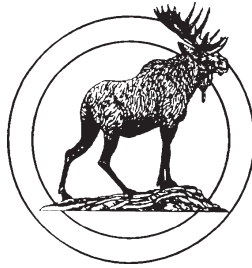

Super Bowl XLVI will be Sunday, February 5th. Who do you think will be playing???

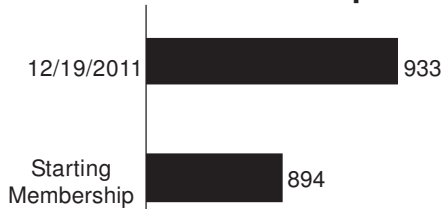

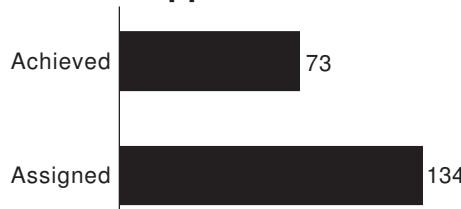

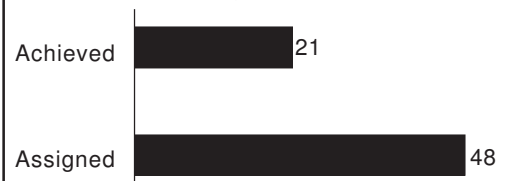
LOOM Application Quota

As of 12/15/11


Moose Legion #47 Application Quota

Seventy-five food boxes were put together and delivered to those that needed them.

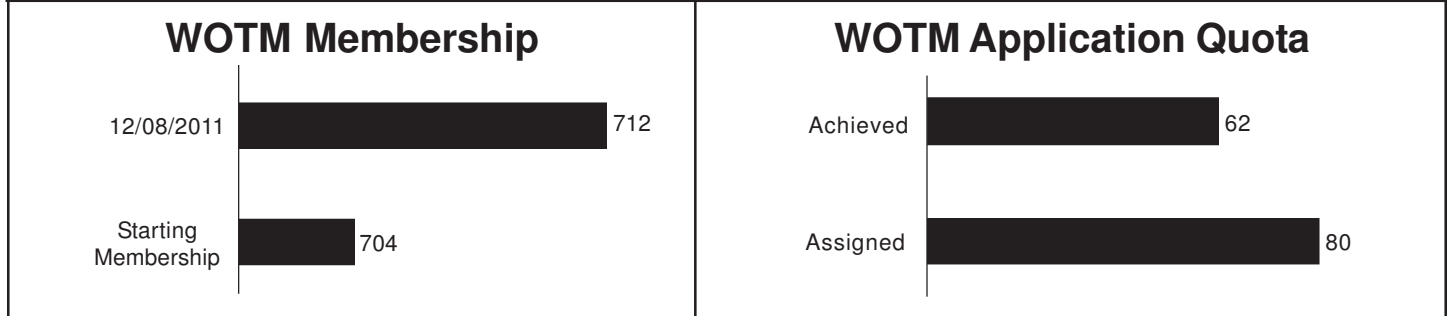
The canned food drive went well and will help many.

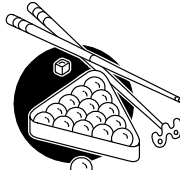
