2009 International Moose Bowling Tournament

1. Loyal Order Moose Members in good standing's at the time of bowling in the tournament. Lodge certification is required. Lodge must also be in good standing in Association.
2. All averages used in this tournament shall be based on 21 games or more.
3. It shall be each bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of his average. Any bowler who submits a false average shall forfeit any and all prize money, and will be suspended from future tournaments.
4. A team, which does not have a full line-up, will not receive any score for an absentee bowler.
5. Any team or individual in this tournament failing to appear on the lanes when scheduled to bowl, shall forfeit the entry unless the tournament secretary finds sufficient reason for granting a postponement.
6. No entry money will be refunded if it is found that some teams or individuals have failed to comply with all the rules and regulations governing this tournament.
7. The tournament secretary and tournament committee shall have full power as to the acceptance of any substitutes offered for any event, supported by proper affidavit, each substitute must bowl under his or name and only at the properly scheduled time.
8. All remittances must be made in the form of a check or money order in US dollars and made to :
Moose International Bowling Tournament.
9. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED OR PROCESSED UNLESS PAID IN FULL.
10. Use highest average of 2007-2008 season. If you do not have a 07-08 average, use highest average as of January 1, 2009 for 21 games or more. Men without sanctioned average must use a 220 tournament average. Handicap will be based on 90% of 220 with a maximum of 60 pins per game. Women without sanctioned average must use a 150 tournament average. Handicap will be based on 90% of 200 with a maximum o 60 pins per game. Summer league averages not accepted.
11. Singles will be bowled first, then doubles. There will normally be scheduled 6 to each pair of lanes in the single and doubles.
12. To participate in the doubles or singles, you must enter both events.
13. USBC rule 319a will be applied which in brief says at the time of entry, the entrant has a current season's average for 21 games or more which is 10 pins or more higher than the previous season's average, the bowler must use his current average for entry in the tournament. USBC 319a states in part, failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to the completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or base prize winnings on submitted average if it is higher. Rule 319E is waived.
14. USBC and non USBC members may participate in a Moral Support sanctioned tournament with high score recognition automatically extended to USBC members. Eligible non league bowlers can qualify for high score recognition, at their option, by paying a \$21.00 sanction fee for which the USBC will issue an affiliated membership.
15. USBC rule 308b: at least one prize for each 10 entries of major fraction thereof.
16. A bowler is not eligible to compete more than once in each event to this tournament with the following exception: Members of the host city lodge only will be allowed to bowl more than once for the out of town teams to fill vacancies, and will qualify for prize money. Bowlers with multiple participation will use their 1st series for all events.
17. No team or individual in this tournament is to be compensated for entry fee, travel fees or expenses incurred because of the tournament, either directly or indirectly from any lodge treasury of the Loyal Order of Moose.
18. **No Carry In Food or Beverages Allowed.**
19. Any rules not covered above will be covered by the USBC rules.
- 20 The tournament manager reserves the right to rerate any entrant prior to bowling for reasons other than those set forth in rule #10.
